They are responsible for the cooking, plating and serving of all meals, and for the delegation of appropriate tasks to the Assistant Cook, Kitchen Assistant and Dishwashers. A strong Camp Cook is an organized leader who is comfortable with a fast paced environment and managing other staff. Depending on candidate availability, more work dates are available.

Job Duties

- Responsible to the Assistant Director and Director
- Responsible for the cooking and plating/serving of all meals
- Responsible for ensuring meals are served on time
- Knowledgeable about all the food stored on the island at all times
- Communicate with the Assistant Director and Food & Inventory Manager with shortages and upcoming shortages
- Ensure that Kitchen staff completes all duties
- Ensure that the Kitchen runs in a smooth, organized manner
- Ensure that food is managed in an economical manner
- Responsible for meeting with campers/staff at the start of each session to get required food needs and allergies
- Responsible for ensuring all food needs are met in terms of allergies and intolerances
- Responsible for showing the dishwashers, at each meal, the proper serving size to ensure that each camper and staff get the same portion
- Other duties as assigned
